

While away the hours watching the ships go by, take a leisurely ride on the Algiers/ Canal Street Ferry, ride a bike or take a walk atop the paved levee path, see art, find a perfect gift, enjoy a yoga class, sip a libation or grab a bite to eat for breakfast, lunch or dinner during a day in Old Algiers. There is a little bit of everything -- from a cup of coffee to a new hairstyle – and much more that is not even visible as you walk or ride through the historic area. And though it may seem remote -- you must cross the river to get to it -- **Old Algiers is only five minutes from the Central Business District and French Quarter via ferry or a 15-minute ride via the Crescent City Connection Bridge**.

Founded in 1719, Old Algiers is the second oldest settled area in *Nouvelle Orleans*. Generally referred to as the King's Plantation (named for Louis XIV of France who granted the land to the founder, Jean Pierre Sieur de Bienville), the land was used for growing crops and livestock and for storing goods, including ammunition, for the French colony that is today's French Quarter. It is also the site where many of the ships carrying enslaved Africans landed, and today a marker enshrines that little-recognized fact in front of the historic Algiers Courthouse, designated during 2019 as a UNESCO Site of Memory.

Old Algiers doesn't even resemble its original state, as over the years – particularly after the 1803 Louisiana Purchase – parcels of land were subdivided and sold as smaller plantations. Later, the plantations were further subdivided and sold off as lots, and by the mid-to-late 1800s, much of the property was owned by industry or individual landowners. Annexed to the City of New Orleans in 1870, it has kept its small-town feel with rows of Craftsmen-style bungalows, Creole cottages, single- and doubleoccupancy shotguns and some grander Victorian homes lining the streets. Groceries, pharmacies, bars and bakeries stood on many a corner property, providing essential goods and services to the community. Since 1975, much of the area has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Today, we honor our history and celebrate our culture, but we are working toward a more equitable and vibrant future for the Old Algiers community. Our efforts include preserving our physical environment while supporting small business development and creating opportunities for residents to develop skills, find employment and own homes in this unique area.

This directory is an opportunity to share our assets with the rest of the City of the New Orleans and with those outside the city.

Explore the history, experience the culture and create a future here – *in Old Algiers*.

Algiers/Canal Street Ferry: Algiers has been served by ferry service since 1827. Today, the Regional Transit Authority operates ferry, bus and streetcar service in New Orleans. For those on the East Bank, the easiest way to get to Old Algiers is via the ferry, which runs every 30 minutes. The fare is \$2 each way, with children under two-years of age free. 



Alex Geriner began making furniture out of necessity. With a limited postgraduate budget for furnishing his 1880s apartment, he decided to create his own. The first piece was an antique headboard, crafted from a five-panel door (hence Doorman) salvaged from a home flooded



by the levee failures after Hurricane Katrina. The old growth cypress panels were inlayed with ornate, 19th-century tin. Word spread, and Geriner began building and selling more beds, slowly growing his operation and expanding offerings to include a wide range of hand-crafted products, including lighting, tables, chairs and more. Realizing his unique position to offer quality, stylish pieces that embodied the charm and grit of the Crescent City, Gernier launched Doorman Designs in 2013. The business uses New Orleans colors, architecture and lifestyle as inspiration for designs that are sold online to customers across the country.
